Entries: 1 - Derby: Choose a Derby division (a combination of dressage and cross country). Course will be ready to walk the day before at 4:00 p.m.

2 - Dressage Test Only: Choose from the four dressage tests above. Tests are judged and scored, but not assigned prizes. All dressage tests will be in the indoor arena.

3 - X-C School: If competing in a Derby, you may school 1 level above or below your Derby Level. If riding twice at the same level, the 1st dressage and the 1st X-C will count for the Derby. Schooling rides are not judged or assigned prizes. Levels will be run in above order.

Late Derby entries accepted with an additional fee of \$15. If space permits, schooling rides may be purchased at the show for an added \$5. No more than 2 X-C rounds per horse.

Entry Form: Request entry forms from the secretary or go to www.msea-ccc.org. Separate entry form for each horse. Entries must be postmarked by the closing date to avoid late fee. Starting times will be sent out by e-mail.

Stabling: Limited overnight and day stabling available. Call MHR 303-841-4323 or e-mail vandaw@comcast.net to reserve space. \$20 overnight and \$10 the day of the show.

Food: Lunch is available on site. LUNCH TICKET INCLUDED with every Derby entry.

Prizes: Ribbons and prizes through 6th place for each Derby Division.

Refunds: \$10 office fee per rider/horse combination is non refundable. Entry monies will be refunded if event is cancelled or if rider cancels prior to closing date. No refunds after closing.

Directions: From I-25 and Parker Rd., take Lincoln east to "T". Turn left (north) on Pine Drive. Pine Drive turns east into Inspiration. Continue approximately 3½ miles to Tomahawk. Turn right, MHR is on the right side.

Rain or Snow: Show may be postponed to the next day, Sunday, or the next weekend. If the footing in the field is slippery, MHR has the option to hold the jumping in the arena only.

Additional Info: EMT on call. ASTM Helmet, boots with heels, vest and medical arm bands mandatory for the jumping. Arm bands will be available for purchase at the show. Casual show attire acceptable. Please leave your dog at home. No Coggins required for instate.
